

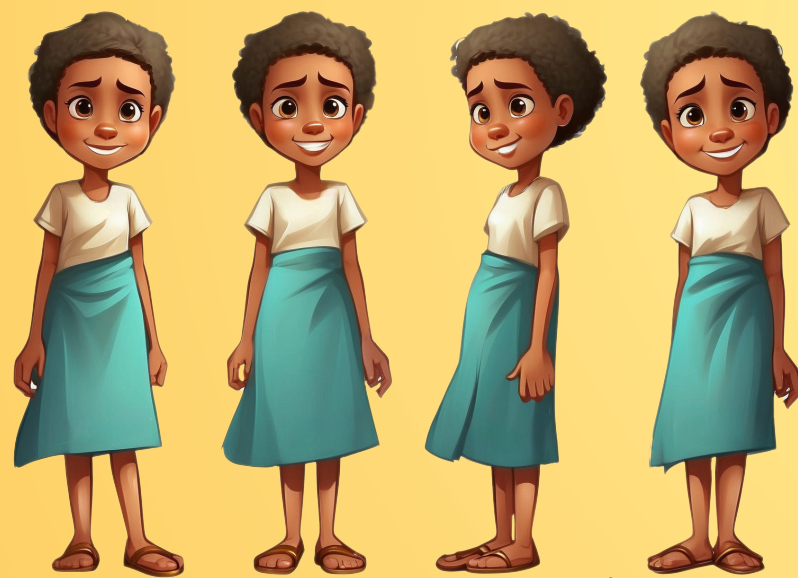


Mansoura's Bright Future
